

Creating Your Own Cuneiform

The Sumerians used a form of writing called cuneiform. It was written with wooden triangular-shaped sticks in the form of hundreds of different wedge-shaped markings on moist clay tablets. The tablets would then dry and harden in the sun and allowed for some of the first permanent record keeping.

Task: You are going to create a cuneiform bookmark. Use the translator on the back of this paper to write your name correctly in cuneiform.

1. Practice on a piece of paper writing letters.
2. Use a ruler and scissors to cut out a piece of construction paper that is 2" by 7 ½".
3. Write your name in cuneiform letters either across or down the construction paper.
4. Put it into good use! Use this bookmark for your future reading.
