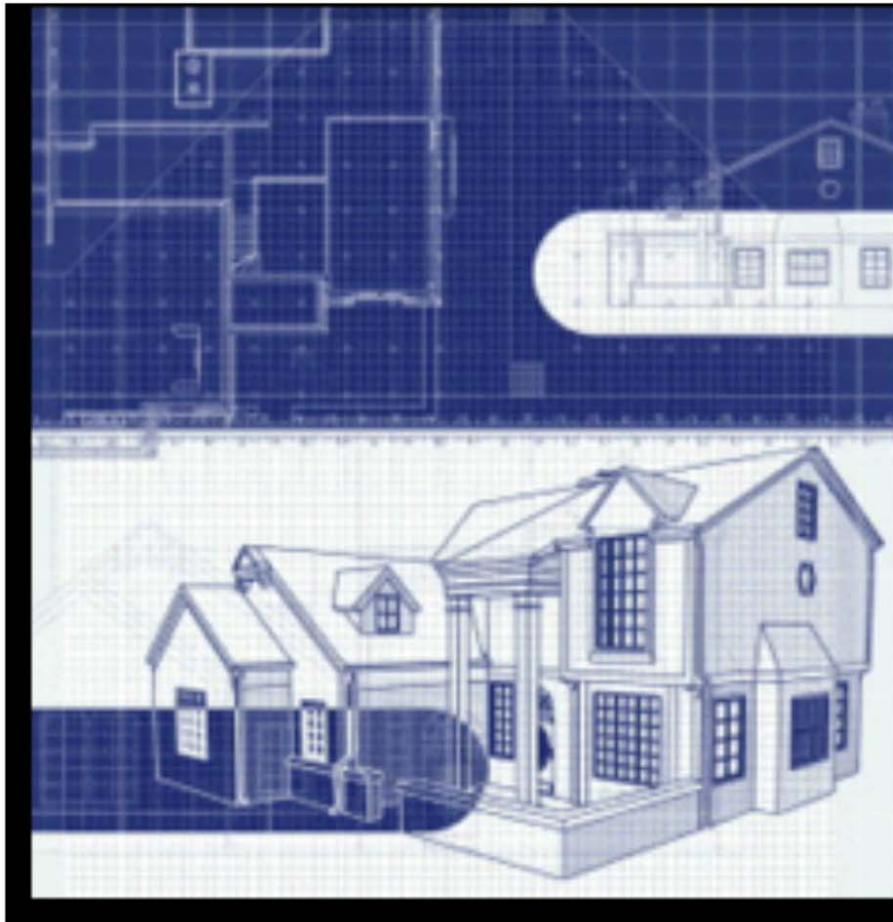

Japan seized (took over) Korea

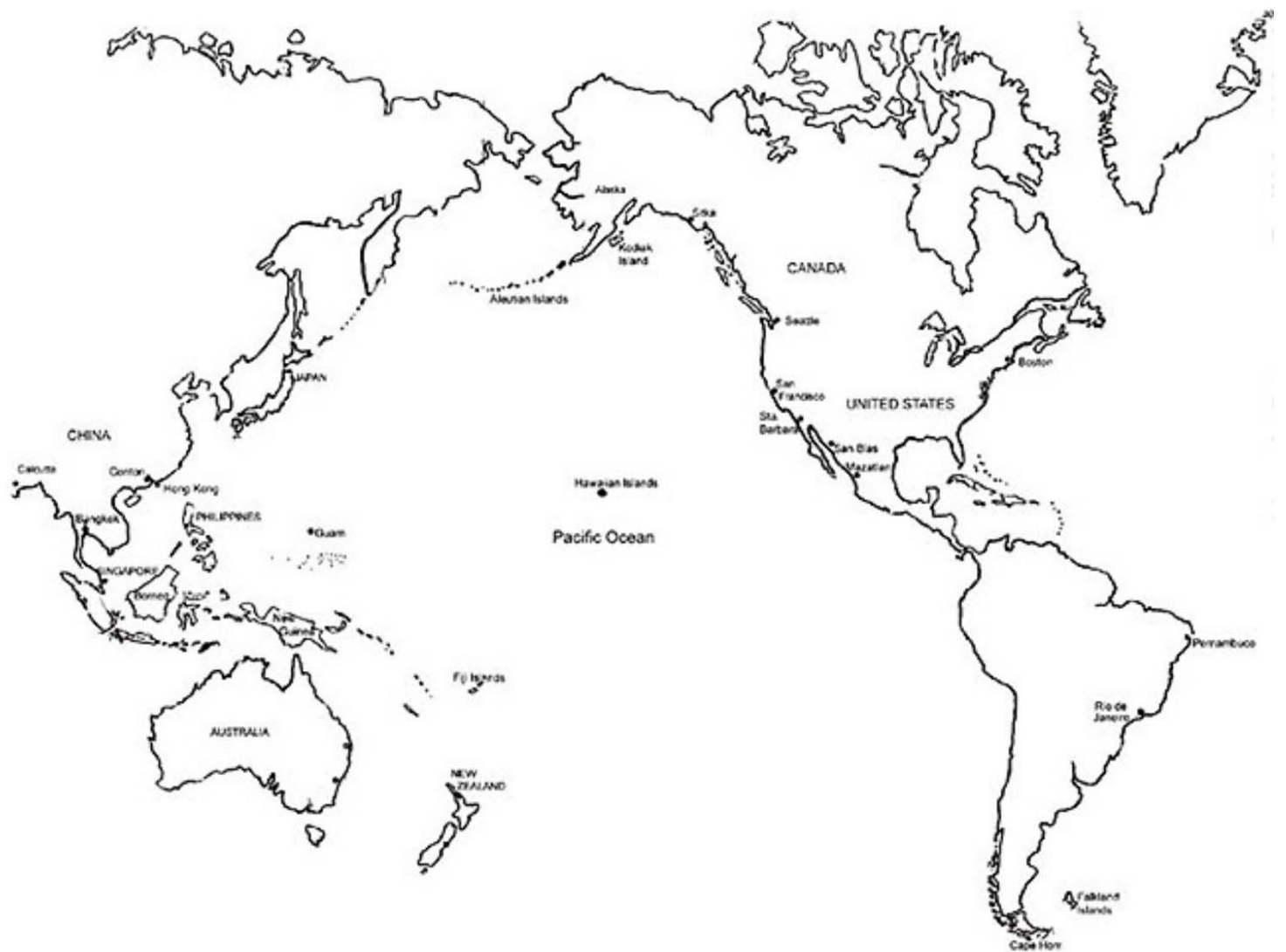
It was the dominating force in Asia, (even though it was not the biggest country).



Japan entered WWII with strong military.

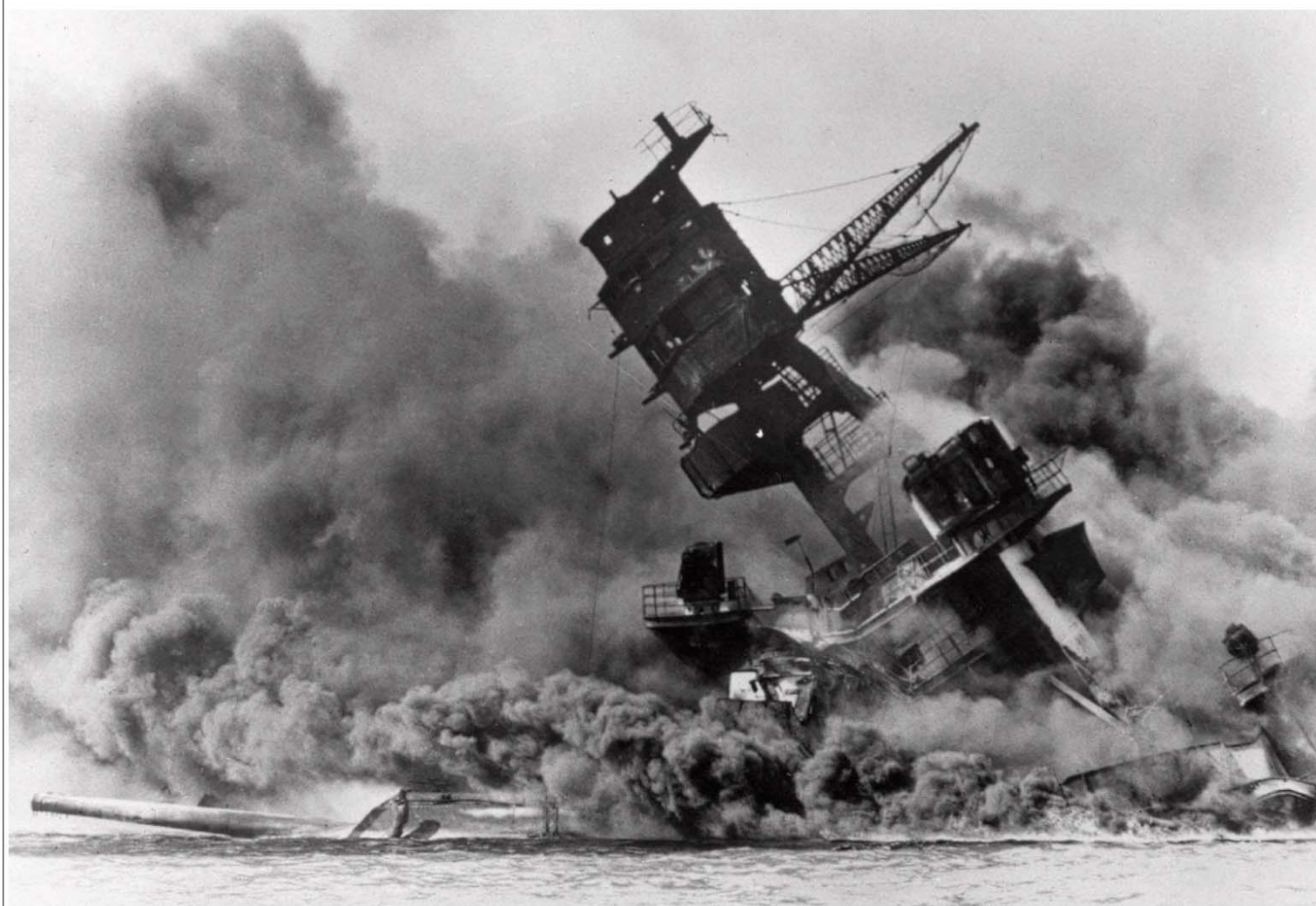
Bombed America at Pearl Harbor (December 7, 1941) in Hawaii because America was helping Japanese enemies by supplying them with war ships, money, etc.

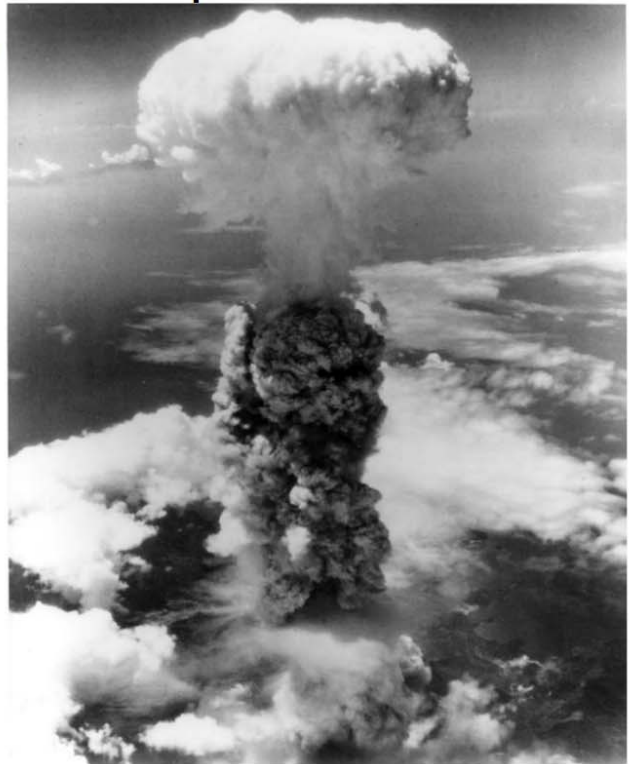




3 years later... America and Japan were both still involved in WWII.
