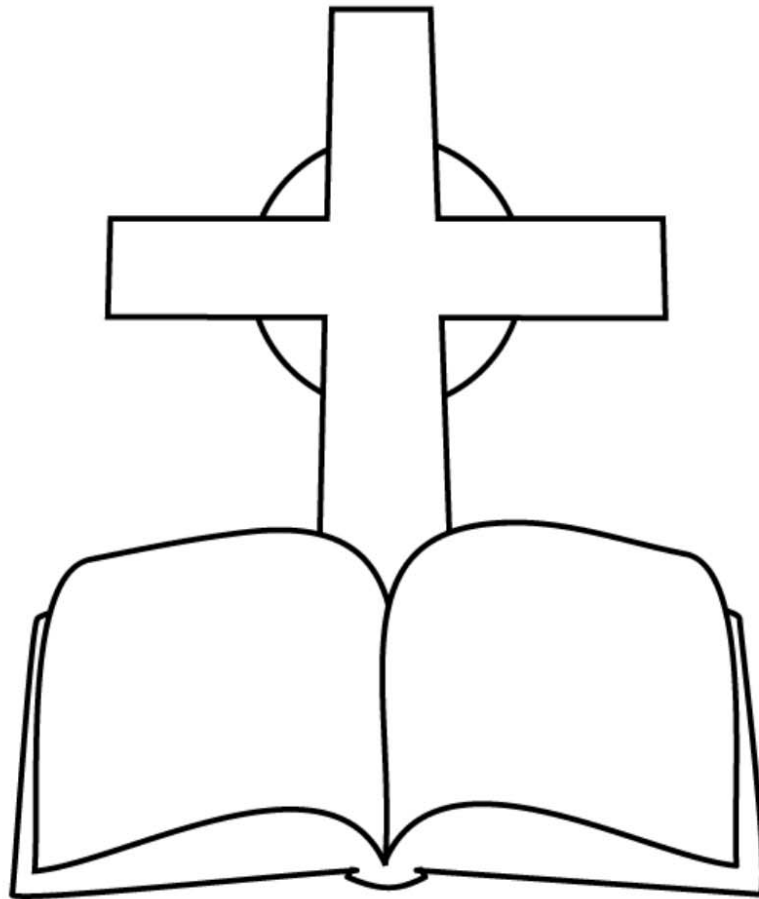

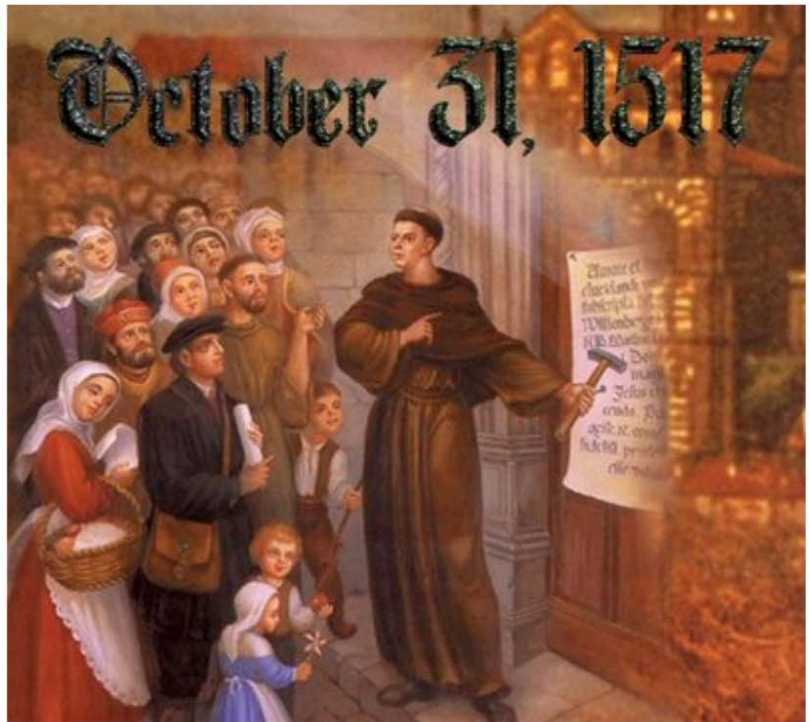
Reformation - To reform, to change

Made of list of 95 things wrong with the catholic church.

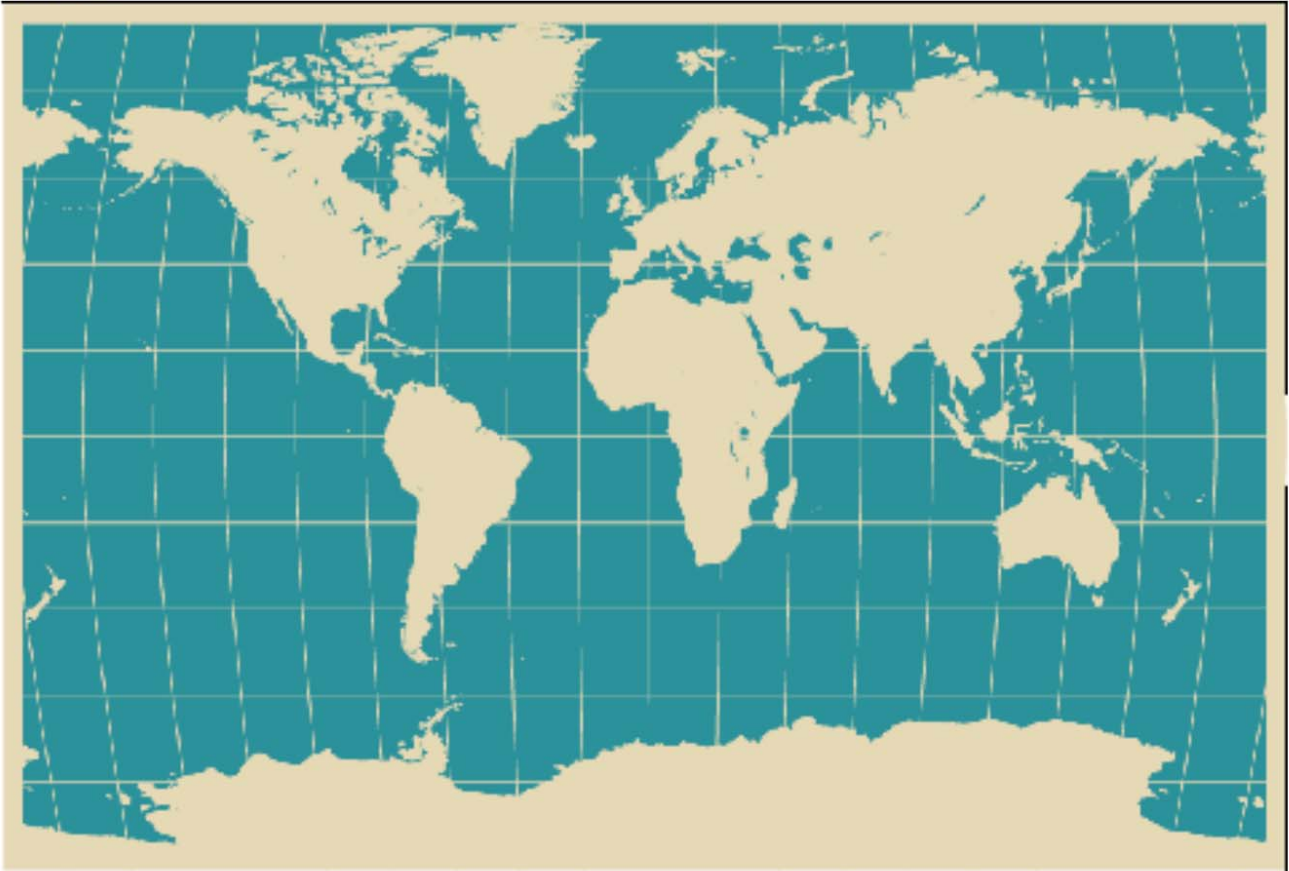
He posted them on the doors!

What was his goals?

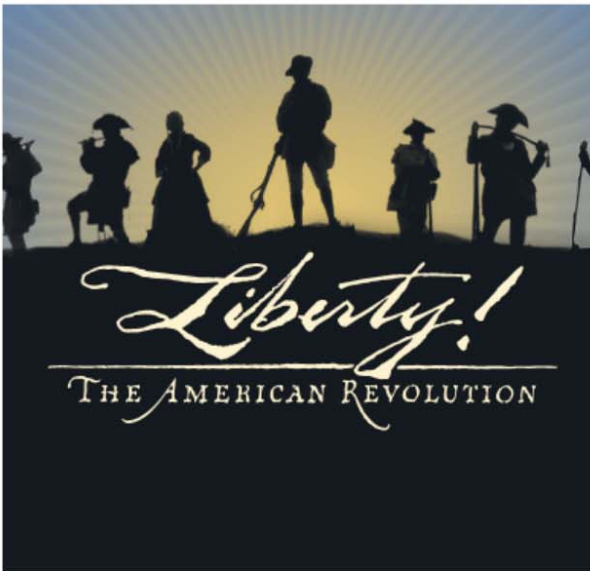
Where did Columbus think
