
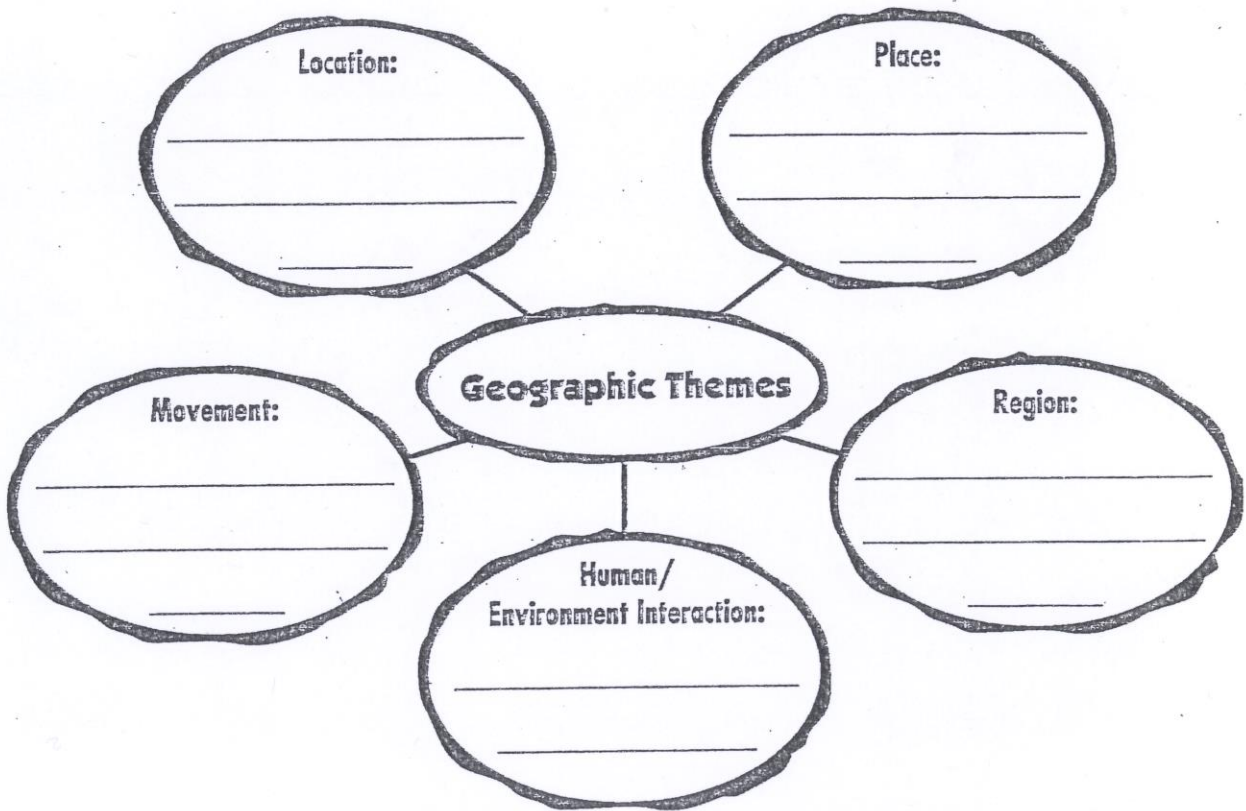


CHAPTER 1 Reteaching Activity
