



Location What's the difference?

Relative Absolute






Place - describes the physical characteristics that distinguish one area from another.

How are they similar? How are they different?





Movement - describes how people from different places interact with one another. This can be done through communication, trade, travel, etc.
How do we communicate?

Region - areas that share common characteristics. Determined by human traits (language, boundaries, religion, occupation) or by physical features (landscape, climate).
