

Lines of longitude are measured in degrees. The Prime Meridian is 0°. All other meridians are numbered east and west of the Prime Meridian up to 180°. The meridians in the Eastern Hemisphere are marked with an E. The meridians in the Western Hemisphere are marked with a W.

- ► Find the Prime Meridian on the map. What oceans does it cross?
- ► Find the 180° meridian on each side of the map. Even though you see it twice, it is really the same line. What oceans does the 180° meridian cross?
- ► Find the 30°E meridian. What continents does the 30°E meridian cross?
- ► Find the 60°W meridian. What continents does the 60°W meridian cross?
- ► Why do the meridians curve?
